In order to begin your MOA courses you must have the following completed:

- MOA Student Contract, signed and submitted to supervising teacher (included in mailing)
- Acceptable Use Policy, signed and submitted to supervising teacher (included in mailing)
- Emergency Medical Form, completed and submitted (included in mailing)
- [Student Handbook](#) Certification, completed and submitted (included in mailing)
- [Free and Reduced Lunch Paperwork](#) submitted, if applicable (click on link for form)
- Chromebook Contract signed and returned, if applicable (included in mailing)

Once all of the above are completed and submitted to the supervising teacher at the building designated, supervising teachers will distribute log-in information.

Where will I pick-up my child's Chromebook?

- Students will pick up their chromebooks from their supervising teacher. The contact information for your supervising teacher will be coming in the mail. Please call or email your supervising teacher to make an appointment to pick up your Chromebook and turn in your paperwork.
