- MTSS Update and Review
 - Where are we at:
 - There is a session at NCCAT. Berrier, Columbia, and Holland will attend two weeks from now
 - There is a session in March for anyone else to go, it would be good if others went so that more people have the training to implement here
 - We are doing some
 - What do we need/questions we have:
 - We need more information on what MTSS is
 - That MTSS is behavior and academic is a bit confusion and would like some more info on how that works
 - There is a lack of resources (staff, tools, time) and we don;t know what to do with what system we currently have.
 - Do we need more steps before students are referred to a specialist
 - What is a data piece to track what things we are doing (because we feel that we do some of these things as a practice, (but maybe to not document it well.)
 - There is not specific person assigned to this process and it feels a bit loose
 - We need a universal and consistent way to document interventions and strategies as a student moves through tiers
 - What can we do now?
 - We have some people to refer students to when needed
 - List of concerns for academic and behavior needs to send with LC and AB
 - We can ask for assistance on grade levels with academic and behavior needs. (Could upgrade it into an 'official form' if needed?)
 - The day treatment center will open up in a couple weeks at NAMS and this is going to be a wonderful resource for our students! (This is considered a Tier 2 intervention) <u>https://www.panoramaed.com/blog/mtss-intervention-strategies</u>
 - in order to get students access to this program, data will be an important piece
