Dear Brentwood Families,

The Brentwood Borough School District was notified today that one High School student and one Elroy Elementary student tested positive for COVID-19. After consultation with the Allegheny County Health Department it was determined that no students or staff were required to quarantine. The ACHD does not support the closing of any district school buildings. The data collected by the ACHD indicates that the spread is occurring outside of the school facilities.

The box below lists the most common symptoms related to COVID-19. The most recent guidance from the CDC recommends testing for students displaying these symptoms. With the increase in the number of testing sites, the results of the tests are returning in 1-3 days which is also helping to stop the spread.

- * These tests are great for young and school-aged children. They don't hurt but might tickle a little. Older children can administer the test themselves. Parents or guardians can help younger children
