Title I

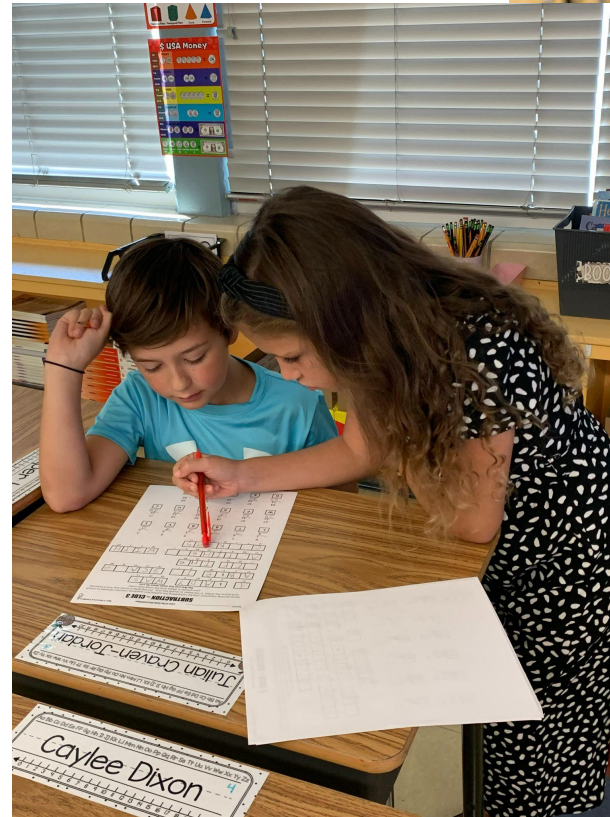
Title I is

Our school's plan each year is derived from a Comprehensive Needs Assessment. We work collaboratively with our district to develop our Title I Plan and primary goals for the academic year.

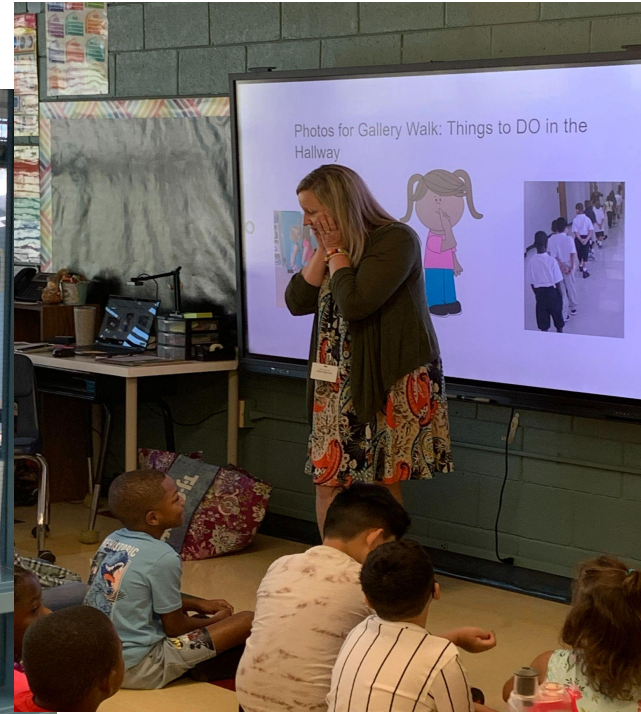

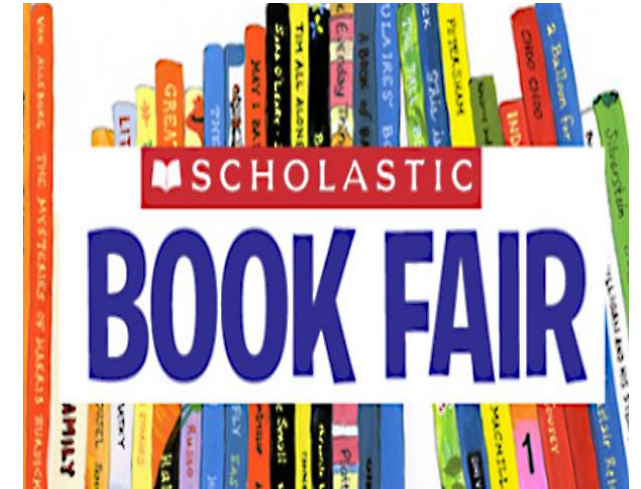
