On **Monday, November 1 & Tuesday, November 2, 2021**, we will be having an In-School Dental Care Program. **Signed permission slips need returned to your child's teacher by Monday, October 4, 2021.**

There is **no charge** to the parent. The In-School Dental Care Program will bill your dental insurance company and/or grant assistance is available. Paramount is accepted by the program. All children are eligible. Permission form attached.

Mobile Dentists/Children Dental Health Foundation is an in-school dental program created in compliance with the Center of Disease Control (CDC) and the U.S. Surgeon General Guidelines.

Important Statistics:

51 million school days LOST due to oral health problems.
More than 60% of children do not receive dental care each year.

Our Ohio dentists provide:

Preventive Care

- Complete dental exam
- Cleaning
- X-Rays*
- Fluoride treatments (including silver diamine fluoride)
- Sealants
- Oral health instruction

Restorative Care

- Fillings
- Simple extractions
- Pulpotomy (Treatment of the nerves inside of baby teeth)
- Crowns

Medicaid/Healthy Start, Healthy Families and most other insurances cover 100% of our treatment. We are funded, in part, by Children's Dental Health Foundation, a 501(c) 3, non-profit foundation.

1. We issue grants to help children receive care (exam, fluoride and cleanings).
2. Our grant also gives us the ability to pay co-pays of private insurance, of families in need. *Grant forms upon request.
3. We supply "report cards" for each visit. If further dental care is needed, an appropriate referral is made.
