Food for Those in Need During the 3-Week School Closure

Food will be available for students and families in need, especially from March 16 through April 2. The school and various community groups are teaming up to make sure families don't go hungry. The following is more information on the availability of food for students and families:

Food Distributed at Hilltop Schools from March 16 – April 2:

- **On Mondays & Thursdays only, from 12:00 – 4:00 pm**: please park at Hilltop Elementary and walk into the front entrance. You may need to ring the doorbell for service. Someone will bring you a supply of groceries and/or ready to eat food items.
- If you are unable to pick up food during the timeframe listed above and need to have food delivered to you, please email Amy Welling at awelling@hilltopcadets.org
- Area churches, the Chamber of Commerce and the Village of West Unity are helping us collect food for distribution. The local police department is partnering with us to help deliver food to those unable to pick it up.


