Reminders

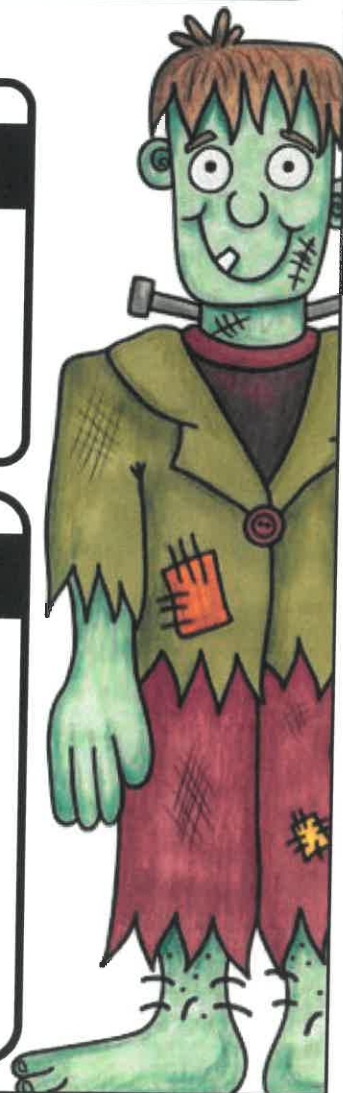

Third Grade Testing

The third grade students will take the Ohio state English Language Arts test on Tuesday, Oct. 20 and Wednesday, Oct 21. Parents are encouraged to give their child a healthy breakfast and make sure they get a good night's sleep. You can help them prepare by reading together and asking questions such as who, what, when, where and why questions. Comparing two books or stories is also an important skill for these tests. Encourage your child to write in complete sentences with capitalization and punctuation.
