## Bath Middle School Band Attendance Policy

Band is a team effort that requires each member's dedication, hard work, and commitment to be successful. If a student misses a performance, he/she has missed the opportunity to contribute to the team and its success. Students must attend all required performances and rehearsals. If a student misses a required event, documentation must be provided prior to the event by parents/guardians explaining the nature of the absence. If the absence is considered excused, the student will have the opportunity to complete a make-up assignment for their portion of the concert grade that will include, but is not limited to, a paper and individual performance of their band music. If the absence is considered unexcused, the student will receive a zero for that performance grade.

## Examples of Excused Absences

Personal Illness (documentation required)
Family Emergency (documentation required)

## Examples Unexcused Absences

Transportation
"I forgot"
Other commitments (sports, parties, etc.)

## Band Uniform

Concerts: Sunday dress (no jeans, athletic wear, or casual footwear)

## Band Rules

The following are guidelines to a successful rehearsal. The student who violates these rules is responsible for reducing the amount of time for rehearsal and consequently hurting the entire band.

1. Be prepared for class! Have your instrument, folder, pencil, accessories, and planner with you every day! The order of rehearsal will be on the board every day!
2. Respect the rights, safety, and property of others:
a. Absolutely NO PLAYING until we play as a group
b. Do not talk during rehearsal. If you have a question, please raise your hand.
c. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
d. No gum, food, or drink in the band room. (except water)
3. Accept responsibility for yourself and your learning.
4. Be a responsible citizen and obey all school rules.

Consequences:

1. Warning
2. Student conference
3. Parental contact/ conference
4. Office referral

Severe disruption: Immediate office referral

## Instrument Requirements

Every member of the Bath Middle School Bands is responsible for proper equipment in daily rehearsals. The following are required and must be in your case or on your stand every rehearsal:

## Woodwinds:

Flute: Cleaning rod, soft cloth
Clarinet: Four playable reeds, reed case, mouthpiece cap
Saxophone: Neck strap, four playable reeds, reed case, mouthpiece cap

## Brass:

All brass players are required to have valve oil on their stand at every rehearsal. You are also responsible to have all of your slides in working condition.

## Percussion:

All percussion players are responsible to have the correct mallets/ sticks at every rehearsal.

## Clarinet/Saxophone Reeds:

Van Doren or Rico (Traditional) 2, $2 \frac{1}{2}$, or 3

- Please ask directors before purchasing reeds so that we can determine which reed will be suitable for your specific needs
- Supplies can be purchased through rettigmusic.com, click on shop, then Bath Local Schools. Supplies can be delivered to school (free of shipping) through our Rettig representative.


## Grading Policy

Letter grades will be given in band and will be determined from the following areas:

## Playing/Rhythm/Written Testing:

100 points each
Bath Middle School Band students will be tested several times in any nine week grading period.

Playing tests will be assigned several days in advance and will usually consist of lips slurs, scales, and a musical passage or etude from the method book that emphasize what the students are learning in class. Students must be prepared to perform their playing tests on the assigned day. Students will always have the opportunity to perform re-takes to improve their playing test grade.

Rhythm tests will be given frequently throughout each grading period. Rhythm testing is designed to evaluate the students' understanding of rhythms in various time signatures. Written testing will consist of any musical terms we are studying. Written testing is designed to evaluate the students understanding of musical terms and musical concepts that we are studying in class.

## Class Participation

## 10 daily points

Students will receive daily participation points for being prepared for class. This includes having all materials: instrument, playable reeds, valve/slide oil, mallets/ sticks, music folder, method book, and pencil. Students will lose points if any of the above materials are missing from daily rehearsals.

## Concert/ After School Rehearsal Attendance

## 100 points each (concerts weighted twice as much)

1. Band is a music performing class, with most performances taking place outside of the school day. Since students elect to take band, we expect that students will participate in all of the performances. This includes evening performances AND weekend performances.
2. Performances are one component of your child's grade. If a student misses a performance, he/she misses the points for that activity.
3. Students will have a make-up assignment for an excused absence ONLY!
4. An unexcused absence will result in a zero for that grade.

## Bath Middle School Band Parent-Student Contract

- As band is an elective course, inappropriate behavior may be cause for removal from the band program at any time. The band directors reserve the right to hold a conference with any parent and student regarding behavior.
- Band students will be evaluated in the categories of playing/rhythm/written evaluation, daily participation, and concert attendance.
- Band is a performance course and all band members will be required to attend after school rehearsals and concerts throughout the year. Participation in these concerts is MANDATORY! Failure to attend a performance could result in a " F " for the nine-week grading period. The music programs at Bath focus on building a team of musicians and only when every member of the band puts forth a $100 \%$ effort can a band attain its goals in musical achievement and service to the community.


## Band Student Responsibilities

- I am responsible for practicing a minimum of 20 minutes, 2 days a week.
- I am responsible for listening carefully in lessons, writing down instructions, and completing my assignments in a timely manner.
- I am responsible for attending all band rehearsals and lessons with my instrument, accessories, band book, pencil, and a positive attitude.
- I am responsible for following directions the first time given, playing my instrument only when instructed, and not playing when the band director is talking.
- I am responsible to come to all rehearsals and concerts on time, properly dressed, and prepared with my instrument and folder.
- I am responsible to treat my instrument with care and respect, clean my instrument regularly, and take proper care of it.
- I am responsible for playing only my instrument and not playing instruments that do not belong to me.
