



New Procedures for Proof of Residency

Before any student is assigned to attend Asheboro City Schools (ACS), the student's parent or legal guardian* must provide proof of legal residence in Asheboro City.

Effective January 1, 2026, all students must submit three proofs of residency.

All documents must be pre-printed with the name and Asheboro City address of the student's parent or legal guardian* and must be presented at the time of enrollment.

Change of address request will require one document from each of the following columns.

All applicants must submit at least **one document from each of the following columns.**
These documents are for address verification, and must all reflect the address provided for enrollment or change of address.

**Legal guardianship/custody may require additional documentation from a court or agency as part of this process.*

The residency policy does not apply to homeless students, as defined by the McKinney-Vento Act.
Group homes are required to provide proofs from Columns A & B only.
