Dear McComb School Community:

After a collaborative meeting with the Hancock County Health Department and the Hancock County schools, McComb School is moving to a Modified Hybrid Schedule based on shared data points. A current COVID-19 dashboard is available on the school website.

- **October 19th-ALL** in-person students in grades **K-5-6** will attend school **FOUR** days a week (M-T-Thurs-Fri) with Wednesday being a remote learning day.
- **November 9th-ALL** in-person students in grades **7-12** will attend school **FOUR** days a week (M-T-Thurs-Fri) with Wednesday being a remote learning day.
- Students in grades 1-4 will continue with their current schedule.
- No changes to students enrolled in the online remote Virtual Classroom
- If the county alert level changes to RED, students will still attend school in-person either in the original Hybrid Schedule or continue with the Modified Hybrid Schedule. This is subject to change based on data from the health department and as always we should be prepared to pivot as necessary.

Bringing students back in a staggered approach allows for adjustments in operational procedures. Keeping Wednesday as a remote learning day maintains critical intervention services and continues the rigorous cleaning of the building.

As we continue moving forward with: Plan-Do-Check-Adjust, there will be challenges. Some bus route times may change and you will be contacted accordingly.

Morning drop off traffic will increase. Make sure your child is ready to exit the vehicle and pull up as far as possible at the drop off spots. Do not stop in front of the door if open space exists. Remember to only enter and exit via Panther Parkway.

Continue with daily health assessments of your child, continue promoting and practicing good hygiene, and keep students at home should they exhibit CDC related symptoms.
