On Monday, April 20, 2020 Governor DeWine closed Ohio schools for the remainder of the year extending our distance learning. The meal pickup program will continue through May 28, 2020. Additional dates and times have been set for students to pick up their personal items and turn in all school owned items such as textbooks, laptops and chargers to end the school year.

The next homework drop off and packet pick-up will be **Thursday-April 30, 2020**. This will be the last schoolwork pickup for the year. Please make sure work for your student is picked up.

School staff will be bagging up all personal items in classrooms and lockers and distribution will be a drive thru system using Panther Parkway to Door # 6.

May 14 7-12 Personal Item Pickup 9:00 am-12:00 pm and 4:00 pm-7:00pm

If you have students in both elementary and 7-12 you can pick all items up on one day

The last day for new assignments/lessons is Friday-May 15, 2020.

On **Thursday-May 21, 2020** all paper packets are due and should be dropped off during the meal pick-up time of 11:00 am-12:00 pm. Students with online coursework should also have all assignments completed on this day as well.
