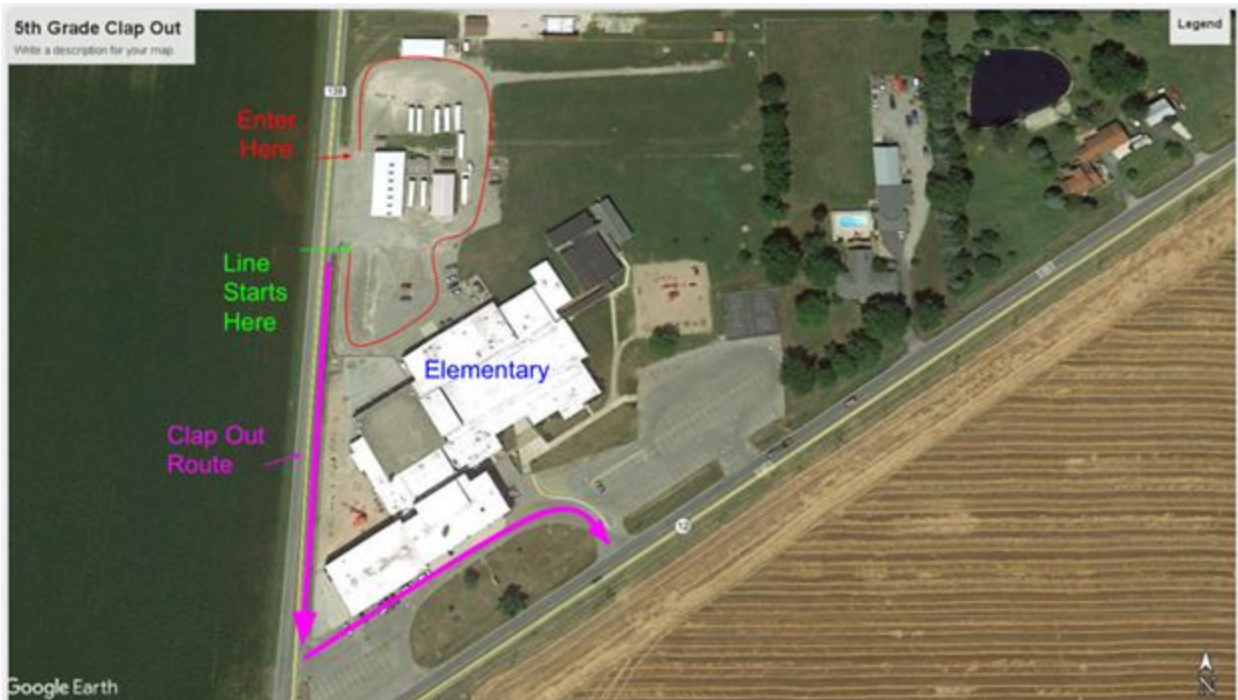


# LIBERTY-BENTON ELEMENTARY 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE CURBSIDE CLAP OUT THURSDAY, MAY 28<sup>TH</sup> – 7:30 P.M.

- This is our annual event where we traditionally clap our 5<sup>th</sup> grade students out of our building on the last day of school to say goodbye.
- **All 5<sup>th</sup> grade families wishing to participate should meet at the rear of the middle school beginning at 7:00 p.m. to line up for this procession. Mr. Burkett and Mr. Horstman will be back there to help direct you into place in the processional line-up. We plan to start promptly at 7:30 p.m.**
- We ask that parents of 5<sup>th</sup> grade students drive their child (and the rest of the family that can fit in one vehicle) through the horseshoe drive in the front of the elementary building beginning at 7:30 p.m. Once you are through the horseshoe drive and exiting on to State Route 12, we ask that you do not turn back on to County 139 and cause traffic back-ups.
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers and the rest of our elementary, teachers, staff and administration will be there to clap our fifth graders out (holding signs, airhorns, clapping, waving our High 5 Friday blue hands, etc.) as you drive by. Due to social distancing concerns, no other students or community members can be out of their vehicles and participating in this receiving line. This is for staff participation only.
- Students **SHOULD NOT** exit their vehicle at any time during the event. We are asking all people involved to remember to maintain all social distancing guidelines as set forth by our Governor and the Ohio Department of Health.
- Feel free to decorate your vehicles... including but not limited to: hanging posters on them, streamers, painting car windows, having your child's name somewhere visible from your vehicle, etc.
