- Friday, April 5, 2024 School in session. Regular instructional day.
- Saturday, April 6, 2024 The Conor Greer 5k event will take place at the high school from 9:00-11:00 a.m. JV Baseball @ Wayne Trace and Varsity Softball @ Bluffton will compete. Baseball/softball pickup/drop off at the bus garage on St. Rt. 12 (old campus). ALL Liberty-Benton Local Schools buildings and grounds are closed following the Conor Greer 5k through Monday, April 8, 2024.
- Monday, April 8, 2024 Remote Learning Day for students. All buildings and grounds are closed.
 Staff do not report.
- Tuesday, April 9, 2024 Anticipated to be open as usual, but subject to change. Calamity day if conditions warrant.

General Information:

- All Liberty-Benton Students will be receiving a pair of eclipse glasses from Hancock County Health,
 The Findlay Hancock-County Community Foundation, and the LBHS Science Department with
 instructions on safe viewing. DO NOT LOOK DIRECTLY AT THE ECLIPSE WITHOUT WEARING ECLIPSE
 GLASSES.
- It is advisable to stay home April 8, 2024. If travel is necessary, pre-plan your route and allow for enough time. Keep you gas tank topped off.

Solar Eclipse Facts:

- Findlay will experience a total solar eclipse on Monday, April 8, 2024. The start of totality will be approximately 3:11 p.m. and last about four minutes. Partial eclipse viewing runs from 1:55 p.m. to 4:26 p.m.
- The last total solar eclipse visible in Ohio was in 1806. The next total solar eclipse viewable in Ohio will be in 2099.
