

Daily Home Screening for Students



Parents: Please complete this short check each morning and record your child's information before your child leaves for school.

SECTION 1: Symptoms

If your child has any of the following symptoms, that indicates a possible illness that may decrease the student's ability to learn and put them at risk for spreading illness to others. Please check your child for these symptoms:

- Temperature 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- Sore throat
- **New** uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever

SECTION 2: Close Contact/Potential Exposure

- Had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID-19
- Traveled to or lived in an area where local, Tribal, territorial, or state health department is reporting a 15% or more infection rate as described in the [COVID-19 Travel Advisory](#), which can be found at coronavirus.ohio.gov.

If the student/parent/caregiver answered YES to any question in Section 1, the student would be excused from school in accordance with existing school illness management policy.

If the student/parent/caregiver answered YES to any question in Section 2, the student would be excused from school for 14 days upon returning from area identified in the [COVID-19 Travel Advisory](#) or for 14 days from last exposure to a confirmed COVID-19 case.

If the student/parent/caregiver answered YES to any question in Section 1 **AND** YES to any question in Section 2, the student should stay home, isolate themselves, monitor health and consult with their healthcare provider for possible COVID-19 testing.

Schools should not require testing results as part of return to school policies.
