Presidential Scholarship

The Northwest State Community College Presidential Scholarship is a full-tuition, renewable scholarship. Covering tuition for three (3) consecutive years, including fall, spring, and summer semesters (not including summer semester immediately after graduation). The amount of recipients of this scholarship is now unlimited to all who qualify.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicant must be a high school senior from Ohio or a High School that has an Ohio Residency Reciprocity Agreement.
- 2. Applicant must be a May/June graduate with a sixth or seventh semester grade point average of 3.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale OR earned 12 credit hours of college level courses as a CCP student with a 3.25 GPA.
- 3. Applicant must earn a college ready ACT or Accuplacer score.
- Applicant must complete an application for admission to NSCC.
- Students are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to apply for Federal aid to help offset any additional educational expenses. NSCC's FAFSA school code is 008677.
- 6. Must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident.

Scholarship Use

The NSCC Presidential Scholarship will be applied to tuition (books and fees not included) only after all other tuitiononly scholarships are used. This scholarship will be awarded for degree seeking students, regardless of full-time or parttime enrollment status.

To Renew the Scholarship

The Presidential Scholarship is renewable for three (3) academic years when recipients meet the following criteria:

- 1. Presidential Scholarship recipients must be degree seeking.
- 2. Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0.
- Recipients must complete 20 volunteer hours each year on campus or an approved location in the community. Students must register for community service events online through SignUp.
- Students are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to apply for Federal aid to help offset any additional educational expenses. NSCC's FAFSA school code is 008677.

Honors Scholarship

The Northwest State Community College Honors Scholarship is a half-tuition, renewable scholarship. Covering half-tuition for three (3) consecutive years, including fall, spring, and summer semesters (not including summer semester immediately after graduation). The amount of recipients of this scholarship is now unlimited to all who qualify.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicant must be a high school senior from Ohio or a High School that has an Ohio Residency Reciprocity Agreement.
- 2. Applicant must be a May/June graduate with a sixth or seventh semester grade point average of 3.25 or higher on a 4.00 scale OR earned 12 credit hours of college level courses as a CCP student with a 3.00 GPA.
- Applicant must earn a college-ready ACT or Accuplacer score.
- 4. Applicant must complete an application for admission to NSCC.
- Students are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to apply for Federal aid to help offset any additional educational expenses. NSCC's FAFSA school code is 008677.
- 6. Must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident.

Scholarship Use

The NSCC Honors Scholarship will be applied to tuition (books and fees not included) only after all other tuition-only scholarships are used. This scholarship will be awarded for degree seeking students, regardless of full-time or part-time enrollment status.

To Renew the Scholarship

The Honors Scholarship is renewable for three (3) academic years when recipients meet the following criteria:

- 1. Honors Scholarship recipients must be degree seeking.
- 2. Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0.
- Recipients must complete 10 volunteer hours each year on campus or an approved location in the community. Students must register for community service events online through SignUp.
- 4. Students are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to apply for Federal aid to help offset any additional educational expenses. NSCC's FAFSA school code is 008677.
