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IF A STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER IS LIVING WITH A COVID-19 POSITIVE PERSON

IS THE STUDENT/STAFF MEMBER EXHIBITING SYMPTOMS?

Parents should contact their child's school nurse to let them know. Staff should notify their supervisor.

Unvaccinated staff or students living with a positive family member AND are not experiencing symptoms may not return to work until:

- they have quarantined for 17 days (10 days of the household member's quarantine + 7 days quarantine after receiving a negative test result between days 15 and 17), OR
- they have quarantined for 20 days (10 days of the household member's quarantine + their own 10 day symptom free quarantine, no testing required), OR
- they have quarantined for 24 days (10 days of the household member's quarantine + their own 14 day quarantine).

IF A STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Following CDC guidance, positive and presumed positive individuals should stay home, separate themselves from others, monitor their symptoms, get tested, and wear a mask.

Parents should contact their child's school nurse to let them know. Staff should notify their supervisor.

Staff and students who have tested positive or who are presumed positive may not return to school/work until:

- 10 days have passed since symptoms started (if symptomatic) or 10 days have passed since date of positive test results (if asymptomatic), AND
- they are fever-free without any fever-reducing medications for 24 hours (if symptomatic), AND
- their symptoms are improving (if symptomatic).

During quarantine/isolation, students will complete asynchronous work via Seesaw or Schoology. Students will be considered present as long as their work is completed.

Our goal is to maintain face-to-face instruction and services to the maximum extent possible, so we will ask staff who have tested positive for COVID or who have been identified as a close contact to take sick or personal leave during their quarantine/isolation. We will provide a substitute for the staff member if needed.

IF A STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER IS IDENTIFIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT TO A COVID-19 POSITIVE PERSON

A close contact is someone who was within 6 feet of a COVID positive individual for 15 or more consecutive minutes. Two people who are more than 6 ft apart are not close contacts.

IS THE STUDENT/STAFF MEMBER EXHIBITING SYMPTOMS?

Was the student/staff member wearing a mask and/or fully vaccinated at time of exposure?

Vaccinated individuals may report to school/work.

Vaccinated and/or masked individuals may report to school/work.

Staff and students should monitor themselves for symptoms for 14 days or until they receive a negative COVID test (can be tested between 3 and 5 days).

They shall also wear a mask for the full 14 day period.

If you were not wearing a mask and not vaccinated you must quarantine for 14 days.

If the individual remains symptom free during quarantine, they may return after 10 days (and continue to monitor their symptoms for the full 14 days) or after 7 days with a negative COVID test between days 5-7 of exposure

They shall also wear a mask for the full 14 day period.

If exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19, following CDC guidance, individuals should stay home, separate themselves from others, monitor their symptoms, get tested, and wear a mask.

Parents should contact their child's school nurse to let them know. Staff should notify their supervisor.
