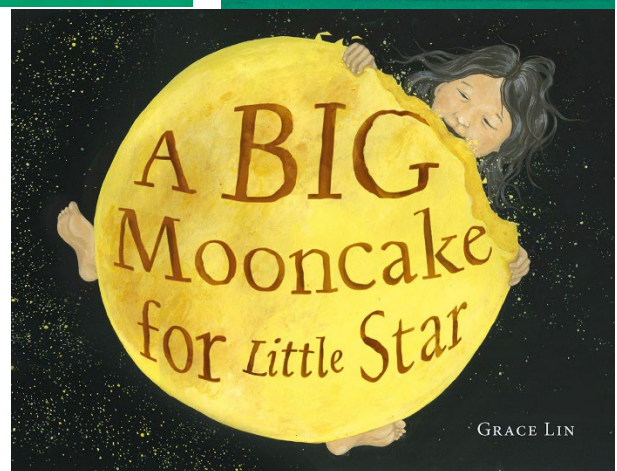
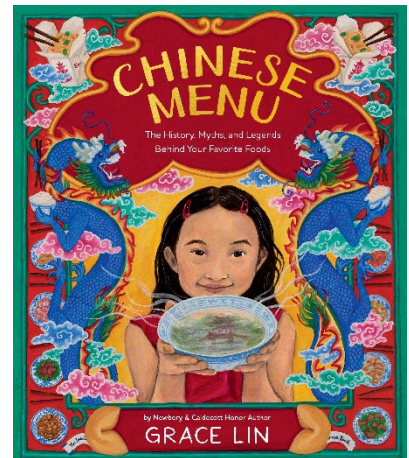
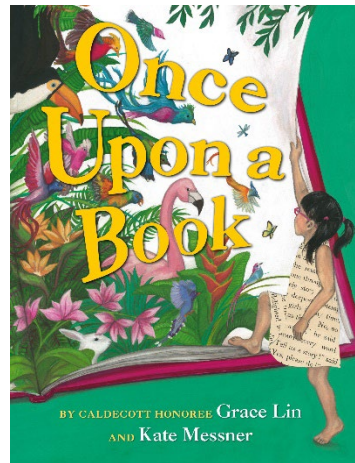

About Grace Lin







Grace Lin, a NY Times bestselling author/illustrator, won the Newbery Honor for *Where the Mountain Meets the Moon* and the Theodor Geisel Honor for *Ling and Ting*. Her novel, *When the Sea Turned to Silver*, was a National Book Award Finalist and her picture book, *A Big Mooncake for Little Star*, was awarded the Caldecott Honor. In 2016, Grace's art was displayed at the White House where Grace, herself, was recognized by President Obama's office as a Champion of Change for Asian American and Pacific Islander Art and Storytelling. In 2022, Grace was awarded the Children's Literature Legacy Award from the American Library Association.
