The Monroe County Department of Public Health issues Quarantine Order for K-12 school employee exposed to COVID-19.

Employee is symptom free for 14 days from their last contact with the COVID 19 case.

AND

Employee is released from quarantine by the Monroe County Department of Public Health.

Employee can return to work in school.

While in quarantine, employee has a temperature $>100^{\circ}$ OR has symptoms of COVID-19 that are new/unusual for them, including:

- Fever, chills
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Cough
- Nasal congestion
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches

NOT RECOMMENDED:

Employee does not get a COVID-19 test: The employee remains in quarantine for 14 days.

COVID-19 test result is negative: The employee remains in quarantine for the remainder of the 14 days.

COVID-19 test result is positive: The employee is placed in Isolation by the MCDPH.

Employee is released from Quarantine or Isolation by the MCDPH.
EMPLOYEE CAN RETURN TO WORK IN SCHOOL.
