POSITIVE SCREENING/School Staff

Employee has a temperature $>100^{\circ}$

OR

Exhibits any symptoms of COVID-19 that are new and unusual for the employee:

Fever, chills • Shortness of breath • Sore throat • Loss of taste or smell •
Headache • Cough • Nasal congestion • Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea • Fatigue •



Employee will remain or be sent home and referred to their health care provider.



Alternative Diagnosis

If your health care provider believes you have an alternative reason for your symptoms AND COVID-19 IS NOT SUSPECTED, you may return to work with a signed note when medically appropriate.



Confirmed Negative COVID-19 Test Result

To return to school, employee must have improving symptoms and obtain:

1. An evaluation document from a health care provider.
2. A lab-confirmed negative COVID-19 test result.



Confirmed Positive COVID-19 Test Result

The MCDPH will place employee in isolation, which lasts a minimum of 10 days.

Employee can return to work in school after being released from isolation by the MCDPH.
