The Board of Education of the Oregon City School District met in special session on October 24, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at 5665 Seaman Road, Oregon, Ohio in the Clay High School Learning Commons. President Carol Molnar called the meeting to order, led the pledge of allegiance to the flag and called for a moment of silence. Upon roll call the following members were present: Mr. Csehi, Mrs. Molnar, Mrs. Miller, Mr. Kennedy, and Mr. Ziviski.

BOARD LEVY DISCUSSION

Mrs. Molnar made a motion,

RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION

(Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.03, 5705.21) Operating Levy

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the present and future requirements of the School District; and

WHEREAS, a resolution declaring the necessity of levying an additional tax outside the ten-mill limitation must be passed and certified to the County Auditor of Lucas County in order to permit the Board to consider the levy of such a tax and must request that the County Auditor certify to the Board the total current tax valuation of the School District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Oregon City School District, Lucas County, Ohio, two thirds of all of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

- Section 1. It is necessary to levy an additional tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of paying current operating expenses of the School District.
- Section 2. The question of such additional tax levy shall be submitted to the electors in the entire territory of the School District at the election to be held therein on March 17, 2020. All of the territory of the School District is in Lucas County, Ohio.
- Section 3. Such additional tax levy shall be at an annual rate not exceeding 4.95 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.495 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, upon the entire territory of the School District, for a continuing period of time.
- Section 4. Such additional tax levy shall be placed upon the tax list and duplicate for the 2020 tax year (commencing in 2020, first due in calendar year 2021), if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.
- Section 5. The Treasurer of this Board is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor of Lucas County, Ohio. This Board hereby requests that the County Auditor certify to this Board the total current tax valuation of the School District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the levy if approved by the voters of the School District.
- Section 6. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
