

2021-2022 Safe Return to Instruction Plan

Asheboro City Schools will operate under Plan A for the 2021-2022 school year. We will provide face-to-face instruction for all students in our buildings following enhanced safety protocols. We will operate under a face-covering mandate until the Asheboro City Board of Education determines it is no longer necessary. The Board will review data and vote on a monthly basis per Session Law 2020-130.

Asheboro City Schools is not planning on utilizing Plan B for the 2021-2022 school year unless it becomes an absolute necessity. Plan C will be utilized for up to five (5) allowable remote days, if warranted by inclement weather or if it becomes necessary to suspend face-to-face instruction due to quarantines and/or staffing shortages. Quarantined students will follow assignments provided by the teacher under the guidance of the principal.
