1. Call to Order: 9:00 a.m.

2. Roll Call (sign in); Introductions

3. *NwOESC BAC Meeting Minutes Review and Approval

- a. A motion to approve the minutes of the NwOESC Business Advisory Council meeting held on May 6, 2025 was made by Nate Johnson and second by Bob Morton. Motion Passed.

4. *NwOESC BAC Plan FY26:

- c. A motion to authorize the NwOESC BAC Co-Chairs to finalize the NwOESC BAC plan for FY26 and submit to ODEW by 9/30/2025 was made by Troy Armstrong and second by Jeff Slattery. Motion Passed.

5. Business Spotlight: Future of Fulton County – Chris Lake, Troy Armstrong, Angie Belcher, Eric Smola and Cara Leininger discussed how they have a partnership with the home district(s), training center, Ohio Means Jobs, and local businesses where the businesses receive a tax credit for hosting internships.

6. Business Spotlight: Advanced Rehabilitation Technology

*A huge thank you to **Advanced Rehabilitation Technology** for hosting our BAC meeting! This gathering provided an excellent opportunity for industry and education leaders to connect, exchange ideas, and explore future collaborations. Together, we can strengthen strategies that better prepare our future workforce and address the skills gaps facing our region.*

- ART Team Opening Comments: Dustin Schlachter discussed what he looks for in his employees. He stated that students in sports he has found are better prepared for the job. Starting pay can be in the \$90-100k range with no college required.
- Groups rotated through 3 stations where they learned about:
 - Construction (S&S Directional Boring)
 - Excavator Competition
 - What makes a good construction employee
 - Municipal Rehab (Advanced Rehabilitation Technology)
 - Manhole Rehabilitation – how this saves communities money

- What makes a good ART Rehab employee
- Coatings (OBIC)
 - Spray lining demonstration
 - Why a company like OBIC is ready for international exposure and what we need to grow.
- ART Team Closing Comments: Dustin Schlachter thanked the group for coming to tour their facility.

7. Member Updates:

- a. Defiance County Economic Development Director Updates and Information Sharing: Cara Leininger shared that a new company, First Quality, is coming to the Central Local School District. They are currently working on housing and an ambassador program. They are estimating 1,000 contracts to build the facility, and 400+ permanent positions once it is open.
- b. Henry County Community Improvement Corporation Director Updates and Information Sharing: Jennifer Arps mentioned that they are working on a date for a local meeting with superintendents.
- c. Williams County Economic Development Director Updates and Information Sharing: Jennifer Stantz discussed the Elevate and Explore program that they have with Bryan City Schools, they are planning a business roundtable, and they are working on a county-wide TIF district.
- d. Northwest State Community College Updates and Information Sharing: Tori Atkinson announced that the CCP textbook budget has been approved again for this year. They had great summer enrollment. They will be having a State of the College address for employees on September 25.
- e. Four County Career Center Updates and Information Sharing: Jeff Slattery discussed the Career Pathway grant that was applied for with steering committee members Mark Rairigh, Bryan City Schools, and Kerri Weir, NWOESC. The award should be announced in October. This would be used to expand access to career tech education for 7th-10th grade students.
- f. AMC/STEAM Updates and Information Sharing: John Mansel-Pleydell talked about Manufacturing Days which will be for freshmen on a few Fridays in October. They are expecting over 400 students. There are seven occupations registered for the manufacturing days. He also discussed the career tree curriculum which has been updated to include 21 soft skills. They are working on updated iPads for the STEAM lab, and he mentioned that AMC is free to join.
