

The following actions were taken by the Northwest Ohio Educational Service Center Governing Board at their regular meeting held May 24, 2022.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by President Brian Baker. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

A moment of silence was observed for Uvalde, Texas and the tragedy experienced at Robb Elementary. Our hearts go out to the students, staff, families, first responders, and entire community affected.

REPORTS:

•OSBA LEGISLATIVE LIAISON: Mr. Brian Baker reported on several legislative items. The House passed HB 333, which would require the state to recommend a job description for school counselors. The bill also would require public schools to consider those recommendations when preparing job descriptions and assigning duties for school counselors. Additionally, HB 333 would require the designation of a school counselor liaison at the Ohio Department of Education. The Senate Primary and Secondary Education Committee amended HB 583, which would extend the current temporary flexibility for school districts regarding the educational requirements of substitute teachers until June 30, 2024. The bill also would establish a study committee to examine the substitute teacher shortage. The committee amended SB 306, which would establish a voluntary tutoring and remedial instruction program that public schools and chartered nonpublic schools could choose to participate in. The bill would require the ESC of Central Ohio to employ tutors and coordinate placement of tutors in participating schools. The bill also would require 16 regional ESCs selected under the bill, in conjunction with the ESC of Central Ohio, to administer the training program for tutors in their regions. The House Primary and Secondary Education Committee passed HB 554, which would require the State Board to issue two-year temporary educator licenses to applicants with expired professional teacher's certificates and professional educator licenses as long as certain requirements are met. The House Higher Education and Career Readiness Committee held a second hearing on HB 577, which would establish the Ohio STEM Gateway Program under the College Credit Plus program that requires a public high school and public college to jointly develop 30 credit-hour pathways in STEM and health care fields. The bill also would allow schools to use existing pathways to meet the 30-credit-hour requirement and would create the Ohio STEM Retention Program that provides an annual tuition waiver of \$2,000 for up to three academic years to a student who completes the Ohio STEM Gateway Program and enrolls in a STEM or health care field at a public college. Finally, the bill would create the Ohio IT Promise Program that provides up to \$4,000 in student loan forgiveness to an individual who meets certain requirements.

•OSBA STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT LIAISON: Dr. Christine Smallman shared several items related to student achievement. Oberlin City's Kurt Russell, who teaches history and African American history at Oberlin High School, has been selected as the 2022 National Teacher of the Year by the Council of Chief State School Officers. Russell says he hopes to focus on diversity and advocate for a well-rounded education. Enrollment in state-funded preschool programs declined last year for the first time in at least two decades, according to the National Institute for Early Education Research's 2021 State of Preschool report. The institute reports a drop of close to 20%, with the greatest decline among students from households of low income and students of color. Roughly two-thirds of high-school teachers and less than half of K-12 teachers participating in a poll said at least one of their students had enrolled but failed to attend class during the 2020-21 school year, according to a report released by the U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO). Teachers surveyed said students lacked at-home support and faced challenges with virtual learning as well as the time required to care for family members and for jobs. The report issued in March and updated in April is the federal government's attempt to understand how the pandemic affected the country's education system. Data was gathered from a national survey of public school teachers. High school teachers were the most affected, with roughly two-thirds, or 65%, having at least one student who never showed up, compared to less than half of teachers in kindergarten to eighth grade. Likewise, teachers in urban schools and those in high-poverty schools were significantly more likely to report having students who never showed up.

•**CFO/TREASURER:** Homer Hendricks shared about processing the fiscal year 2023 school year service agreements and the fiscal year 2022 final program costs. He reviewed the EANS 1 and EANS 2 programs, working with ODE and area nonpublic schools. Mr. Hendricks also discussed new grants from Covid-relief funds that are tied either to current grants or to address requirements from new dyslexia laws.

•**DIRECTOR OF SPECIAL EDUCATION:** Jill Gilliland shared that supervisors are doing a great job of moving forward with hiring for the 22-23 school year. Thank you to Lisa Bailey and Brandi Nafziger for their work in advertising our job postings so that we can continue to hire great educators! IEC teachers attended a half-day “activation” training for both Math and English/Language Arts curriculum held on May 9 and 16. We have additional training scheduled for May 26 and August 15, 2022. We are excited to have these resources for our staff and students! Thank you to Jody Dunham and Jestine Curry for their work in coordinating the PD and supporting our IEC staff to become familiar with the new resources.

•**DIRECTOR OF CURRICULUM, INSTRUCTION, & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT:** Andy Hunter reported that last week 25 area superintendents and administrators were trained in the OPES 2.0 evaluation system at the NwOESC. All districts will be implementing this new system for the 2022-2023 school year. He also noted that the week of June 6-9, 348 students will be joining us at Archbold Elementary for Summer Honors Academy.

•**DIRECTOR OF TECHNOLOGY & OPERATIONS:** Chad Rex shared that the technology department finalized plans for network closet upgrades at both IEC and the ESC office building. Mr. Rex has been working with software vendors to configure the backend in order for successful curriculum software rollouts at the IEC. Mr. Rex also reported that the IEC received their new cafeteria tables. Three tables with gray tops and blue seats were moved into the cafeteria by Chuck Lero and Corey Todd. The operations team is working diligently toward finalizing HVAC project proposals and quotes for IEC and the ESC office building. Mr. Rex has met with Larry Davis and Ashleigh Repp to plan and coordinate transportation supervision, certification and professional development work. The Four County Career Center students completed their portion of the landscape project at the ESC building. In addition to removing select items from the landscape to make room for new plantings, Larry Davis coordinated a project in the south parking lot area. Students mulched an area along the lot and the trees. Mr. Rex commended Mr. Eric Hite and his students for their hard work!
