Bexley City Schools - Service Model Task Force Info

The Purpose of the Service Model Task Force: To evaluate district structures and assess new options to increase contact time and consistency with Bexley students without diminishing the quality of teaching and learning and the health and safety efforts in place.

The charge from Dr. Good: Determine a continuum of service models (aka learning model, instructional model, learning mode.) Evaluate structures currently in place and consider new possibilities.

Three essential questions to be answered:

- How **might we revise our existing service model** to increase contact time and consistency with our students without diminishing the quality of teaching and learning and health and safety efforts at the start of the second semester?
- What **new** service models would enhance our continuum of service models with an increase in contact time and consistency with students without diminishing the quality of teaching and learning and health and safety efforts at the start of the second semester?
- How do we engage stakeholders and communicate our work?

Recommendations to Move Forward to the Task Force

- Today's goal: Determine the AA recommendations Ben, Bill, and Josh will take forward to the Task Force on Wednesday evening?
 - What revisions are suggested to the existing model?
 - If we stay with AAZBB, what might we change to increase contact time and consistency?
 - What new model(s) is recommended?
 - Move to an AM/PM model
 - 3 hour learning sessions
 - Increase in contact time and consistency by having all K-5 students in school every day (15 hours spread across a week vs. 13 hours and 30 minutes in 2 days)
 - Maintain 1.5 hours in between AM/PM to allow for cleaning, teacher lunch, and instruction for band and strings students.
 - Allied arts offered 2X per week
 - Allied arts sessions at 40 minutes in length
 - Allied arts faculty work with the AM/PM sections of a class on the same day to support consistency for general and specialized faculty
 - Recommendation from Dr. Williams to limit the number of sections that an allied arts faculty member sees in one week if possible.
 - Librarians will provide opportunities for a 15 minute book checkout every two weeks. Librarians may integrate into the classroom to co-teach with classroom teachers.
 - How do we engage stakeholders and communicate our work?
 - How will we begin to support principals, specialists, and gen ed faculty in the development of building schedules?
 - Will there be any additional remote activities that students could elect to do? (Ex. choice board activities or at home practice?
