Our Schools

- Bexley has 3 neighborhood elementary schools, 1 middle school and 1 high school which are on 3 different campuses.
- The district is currently guided by a 3-year strategic plan.
- Bexley City Schools offers a variety and diverse selection of programs for its students and is comparable in offerings to larger districts.
- Our schools are supported by and work with multiple organizations, including school building PTOs, Special Education and Gifted PTOs, Bexley Education Stronger Together (BEST), Bexley Minority Parent Alliance (BMPA), Developmental Assets Resource Network (DARN), Athletic, Music and Theater booster groups, as well as other groups such as Bexley Recreation & Parks, the Community Foundation, Bexley Anti-Racism Project, and the City of Bexley.
- The district is also supported by a dedicated partner, the Bexley Education Foundation, which provides additional funding through private dollars for educational initiatives, teacher and classroom grants, and district-wide impact grants.

Our Staff

- Bexley has 300 employees with 200 belonging to the teaching or support services profession.
- 76% of our teachers hold a master's degree or higher and 47.5% have more than 15 years of experience.

Our Students

- Bexley serves more than 2,400 students across 2 square miles with limited transportation.
- Enrollment has been growing, despite the community being landlocked for decades.
- Bexley has a strong graduation rate and a 2020 AP Test pass rate of 85%.
- In the 2020-2021 school year, Bexley launched a one-to-one technology program with financial support from the Bexley Education Foundation.

Our Board of Education

- Members of the Board are elected at large by qualified voters of the District on a nonpartisan ballot.
- The Board consists of five members each of which is elected to a four-year term.
- The four-year terms are staggered so that two members are elected in one-half of the four-year period, and three elected in the other half.

- Bexley is a primarily residential, urban suburb of Columbus, Ohio and is uniquely situated between the Columbus International airport and downtown.
- The community is known for its close-knit feel, walkable tree-lined streets, and main street environment.
- Bexley is noted for its high performing public and private schools and is home to Capital University.
