Through the generosity and kindness of the Donahue Family Foundation, the Golden Apple Award has been established to honor outstanding teachers who devote their lives to teaching in Catholic schools. The Golden Apple Award will be given to a total of six teachers; four elementary teachers and two high school teachers and one principal. The award will consist of a cash award of \$5,000, a certificate, a Golden Apple paper weight, and a Golden Apple lapel pin, presented at a ceremony. The candidate must be a practicing Catholic, full time, and have completed three full years as a teacher or principal.

The applicant must be nominated according to the nomination process. Nominations for a teacher or principal may be made in one of the following ways: by a teacher; by any parent; by an elementary student along with his/her parent.
