<u>PLAYDOUGH RECIPE</u>

- 3/4 Cup Salt
- 1½ Cups Flour
- 1 ½ Cups Water (add food coloring to water)
- 1 Tablespoon Cream of Tartar
- 1½ Tablespoons Cooking Oil

Mix together in a skillet and cook over low heat, stirring constantly. Keep stirring until the mixture cleans the side of the pan. <u>DO NOT UNDERCOOK</u>. Remove from heat, beat and then cool. Knead until pliable. Add flour if sticky or reheat until it is not sticky to touch. Put in a plastic bag and keep it soft in a large plastic container. (A medium size margarine tub or Cool Whip tub will fit inside the child's desk.)
