

Senior Week (May 11-May 15)

Monday, May 11: Senior Exams (Periods 1-4)

Seniors who have to take a final exam for periods 1-4 will report to the HS cafeteria at 8:30 a.m. Any senior who is not scheduled for an exam on Tuesday may turn in his or her laptop at the completion of Day 1 exams.

Tuesday, May 12: Senior Exams (Periods 5-7) and Laptop Turn in

Seniors who have to take a final exam for periods 5-7 will report to the high HS cafeteria at 8:30 a.m. All laptops will be turned in after their last exam is taken.

*Seniors who are earning high school credit only and have a Year-To-Date grade of 90% or higher are exempt from final exams.

*Seniors who are enrolled as CCP students will adhere to the CCP final exam criteria, which may include taking the final exam even if the YTD average is 90% or higher.

*Seniors who are exempt from Final Exams may turn their laptops in to Mrs. Birkemeier at any time during regular school hours on Monday, May 11 or Tuesday, May 12.

SENIOR WALKTHROUGH 1:45-2:15

Our annual Senior Walkthrough will start at 1:45 on Wednesday, May 14. Graduates will begin their walk through the elementary hallways and exit into the bus parking lot. They will proceed to the area between the middle school and football field and eventually end at the high school doors near the cafeteria. All other students in the district will line the parking lots to congratulate and celebrate them. Seniors who are interested in participating should wear their caps and gowns and are encouraged to park in the HS west lot near the football field and/or between the MS and HS. They will follow the itinerary below.

1:45 p.m. Meet Mr. Renner in front of the elementary school WITH YOUR CAP AND GOWN ON.

- 1:55 p.m. Senior Walkthrough begins at the far west end of the elementary school. Seniors will exit the elementary school and proceed through the bus lot towards the middle school. Seniors will walk between the middle school and football field. Seniors will proceed through the HS band parking to Door 5 (HS cafeteria).
- 2:05 p.m. Senior Walkthrough ends in the high school gym.

Thursday, May 14: Senior Scholarship/Awards Ceremony

This year's ceremony will be held on Thursday, May 14 @ 8:30 a.m. in the HS auditorium. Seniors who have earned an academic scholarship, local scholarship, honor's cords/stoles, athletic scholarship, apprenticeship, associate's degree, college certification, military enlistment/awards, and/or athletic award will receive their award from designated presenters. Invitations will be extended to any student who has received an award or scholarship. Family members are welcomed to attend. However, every senior will not be recognized at this event.

Friday, May 15: (Mandatory) Senior Breakfast/Graduation Practice

Senior Breakfast will begin at 8:30 a.m. in the high school cafeteria. **This is a mandatory event for all seniors who plan to walk at our graduation.** Senior Breakfast is for staff and students only. During breakfast, we will share each graduate's future plans and distribute diploma seals, senior sign boards, and any other items needing returned prior to graduation. At the conclusion of breakfast, seniors will begin lining up for graduation practice. **Any senior who is not present at Senior Breakfast and Graduation Practice will not be permitted to walk at graduation.**

Sunday, May 17: Bath High School Commencement

This year's commencement ceremony is Sunday, May 17 @ 2:00 p.m. in the football stadium. Seniors should be at the high school no later than 1:15.

Ladies will meet in the cafeteria and should wear light-colored dresses with flat-bottomed heels, sandals, or shoes. Pointed heels will not be permitted on the turf.

Gentlemen will meet in the cafeteria and should wear a light-colored shirt with a tie, dress pants, and dress shoes.

Graduates will line up for graduation at 1:40. Caps are not permitted to be decorated for graduation. Graduates should pick up their diplomas in the cafeteria immediately following the ceremony.

In the event of inclement weather, commencement will be moved to the high school gymnasium. Graduates will be given 10 tickets for guests during Friday's Senior Breakfast. Once all participating seniors have received their tickets, extra tickets may be distributed on a first come-first serve basis.
