Please read the following information about upcoming dates and events at Bath High School for the month of February.

JOSTENS

A representative from Jostens will be here on **Wednesday, February 4** to meet with the Class of 2029 about class rings. The meeting will take place in the auditorium during Wildcat Time. They will return on **Wednesday, February 11** to take orders for class rings during Wildcat Time.

On **Wednesday, February 11**, Jostens will also deliver graduation items for the Class of 2026 during Wildcat Time and after school from 4:30-6:00 in the auditorium lobby.

PREVIEW DAY FOR 8th GRADE

On February 6th, our 8th graders will be visiting the high school for Preview Day, led by the Guidance Department and our Positive Peer Advocates. During the tour, students will explore the building, visit classrooms (including elective spaces), and learn about high school clubs, activities, and ways to get involved. This experience is designed to help students feel comfortable, excited, and confident as they prepare for the transition to high school.

SCHEDULING

High school counselors will meet with students the week of **February 9-13** to discuss scheduling for the 2026-2027 school year.

Course request forms with parent/guardian signatures are due on **Friday, February 20**.

Students will input their schedules on **March 2 (Class of 2029)**, **March 3 (Class of 2028)**, and **March 4 (Class of 2027)**.

Student registration in a course requires a commitment to that course; therefore, following registration deadlines, course changes will only be considered for the following reasons:

- 1) Lack of a required course needed for graduation
- 2) Failure to meet the prerequisites for a course
- 3) Procedural errors in the registration process
- 4) Completion of a summer course for credit recovery or CCP credit
- 5) CCP equivalent courses

CCP INTENT AND COUNSELING FORMS

Any student who may be interested in participating in the College Credit Plus (CCP) Program for the 2026-2027 school year must submit an intent form to the guidance office by April 1.

3rd QUARTER INTERIM GRADES- These will be posted online on **Friday, February 20.**

STATE-FUNDED ACT

The state-funded ACT for juniors is scheduled for **Tuesday, February 24.** The test is free for any junior at Bath or Apollo. Those taking the ACT should report directly to the HS gym. Testing will begin at 8:30 a.m., and students will be dismissed at the conclusion of testing (approximately 12:00). Any student who chooses to opt-out of this year's test is expected to attend school on the regular schedule. Opt-out forms can be picked up in the guidance office or on the high school website. The remaining grade levels will operate on a regular schedule on ACT Day. If school is delayed or cancelled, the make-up date is March 10.

CANCELLATION DAYS (6 AND BEYOND)

Any future days missed due to weather or other purposes will result in remote learning days with students working from home. All assignments will be posted in [Schoology](#), and students are expected to access and submit their assignments for each course. .

Below are the expectations for remote learning days.

Remote Learning Day Procedures:

- Assignments should be posted in Schoology by 10:30 am.
- Activities/assignments should be equivalent to the length of a single class period for a 2-hour delay (approximately 25-30 minutes).
- Activities/assignments will be a continuation of learning.
- Students' attendance on remote learning days will be determined by their completion of their assignments for that day.

2ND QUARTER AND SEMESTER GRADES

2nd quarter grades have been finalized and posted in Schoology.

Due to this week's cancellations, we need a few extra days to administer semester exams and finalize semester grades. A text alert will be sent to parents and students once the final semester grades are posted in Progressbook.
