## NEW Parent Final Forms Software, replaces OneView-Update Required Yearly

Bath School District has implemented **NEW** registration software Final Forms, to take care of registration, open enrollment, and all student updates. The **Final Forms** Parent Portal can be found on the Bath website: [www.bathwildcats.org](http://www.bathwildcats.org). Once you click the registration tab, Parents will need to create a new account for their student updates. The website will guide you through several steps to input all information needed by the district. Please provide **ALL information** that is asked for, as this information is used to update our files. **Final Forms** is where you will need to input any changes that have occurred over the summer or throughout the school year.

## ATTENDANCE POLICY

The attendance policy for the 2023-24 school year is detailed below. ***Please read the policy carefully so that we can avoid any misunderstanding.*** If you have any questions, please call the high school office. If a student is absent, the parent must call the school (419-221-0366). If we are not called, a written note will be necessary when the student returns. All students are required to report to the office before 8:28 a.m. following the absence from school. Students with excused absences are solely responsible for making up any schoolwork missed.

**MEDICALLY EXCUSED:** Students/Parents must present the office with a note written by a licensed physician or medical doctor. The note must specify which days of school the student was unable to attend. The note must be presented to the high school office within two weeks of medical appointments in order for those days to be excused. **THE TWO WEEK WINDOW WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** A medical excuse is defined as “\_\_ has been under my care from \_\_to\_\_ and may return to school on\_\_”.

**EXCUSED ABSENCES:** Students are permitted to miss **10 DAYS for the Entire School YEAR** without medical notes. In order for those “call ins” to be excused, a parent/guardian must speak to the office explaining the reason for the student’s absence within 24 hours of the absence. If the absence is for any of the following reasons, the absence will be excused. These absences are based on one or more of the following conditions. (1) personal illness (2) death or illness in the immediate family (3) observance of a religious holiday and (4) other circumstance which may constitute an excused absence will require prior approval from the Principal or Assistant Principal. Students with excused absences are solely responsible for making up missed schoolwork.
