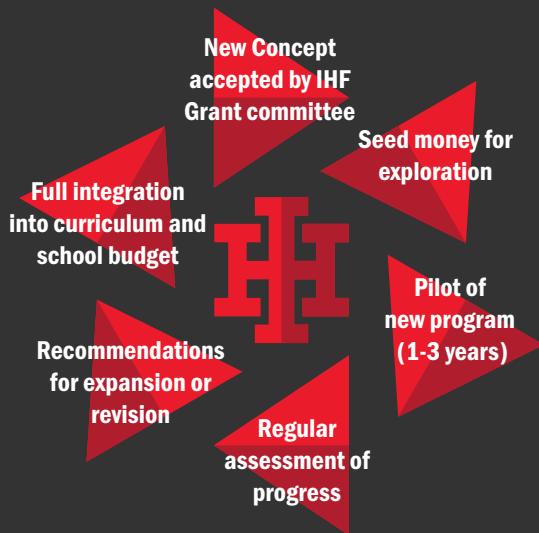


# INNOVATION GRANTS
