or "bus note" (see parent portal for details).



Dances - The DJ had the tunes playing and on 2 separate Fridays the 5th/6th grades and 7th/8th grades got their groove on!


Friendship Grams / Leap Frog sale - The PTO and student council collaborated in selling lions and bears for Valentine's Day and frogs for Leap Day!


