NORTHVIEW HIGH SCHOOL DANCE RULES & EXPECTATIONS For Use by NORTHVIEW DANCE GUESTS

Attendance

- In order to attend dances at Sylvania Schools, students must have their Student Information/Medical & Consent Forms completed in OneView prior to the dance. If forms are not completed, students will be denied admission.
- Photo identification is required of all students and guests prior to being admitted into the dance.
- Students who arrive at the dance 1 hour, 15 minutes after the published start time of the dance will not be admitted. No refund will be provided.
- Dance guests are required to attend and remain at the dance for the duration of the published event time.

Behavior

- Student behavior is expected to reflect standards of the Northview Community and Northview High School and be in accordance with the expectations and rules of our school.
- The Student Code of Conduct is in effect at all dances and also applies to all guests of Sylvania students. If students or their guests violate the Student Code of Conduct, they will be removed from the dance and will not be issued a refund, and will be subject to school disciplinary action.

Dancing

- Dancing cannot imitate a sexual act. Hands need to be placed appropriately.
 - Consequences: At the 1st offense, students will be given a warning. At the 2nd offense, students will be removed from the dance and a parent will be notified.

Guests

- Students from other high schools will be allowed to attend our school dances as a guest of a current student.
 They must turn in a permission form signed by their parents and current school administrator. All guests are required to present photo identification before being admitted to the dance.
- Junior High students or non-Sylvania students older than 20-years of age are not permitted to attend high school dances.

Drugs/Alcohol

- Students may be breathalyzed before being admitted to high school dances.
 - Consequences: If the test is positive, school consequences will be issued by the administration and the
 police will also issue community consequences.
- Any student in possession of drugs, alcohol, or vaping paraphernalia will not be permitted into the dance and will be held by the school until parents are notified.
- Any student caught drinking or vaping during the dance will be held by school authority until parents are notified.

Consequences

- Any students who violate the Sylvania Student Code of Conduct or any rules outlined above are subject to school discipline including suspension or recommendation of expulsion, as well as athletic coding (when applicable).
- Any Agent/Representative (including chaperones) have the right to remove any person from the dance who is in violation of the above rules and expectations and the student will not be entitled to any refund of monies paid.
