Kindergarteners showed off their favorite colors and shared a poem in celebration of Martin Luther King Jr. Day.



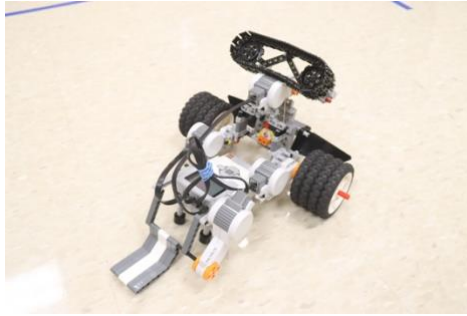
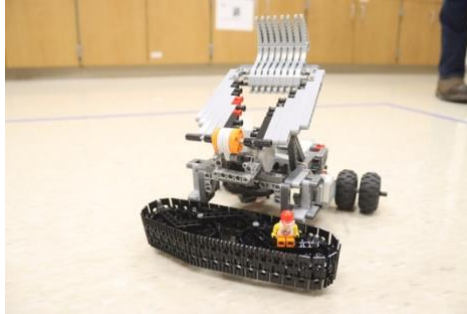
Junior Carlie Bellman reads a story to kindergarteners on their 100th day celebration, which was filled with construction site activities.

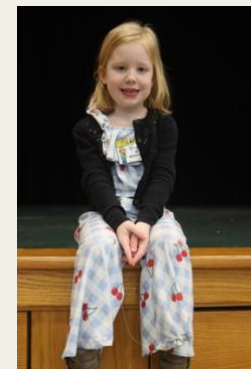
