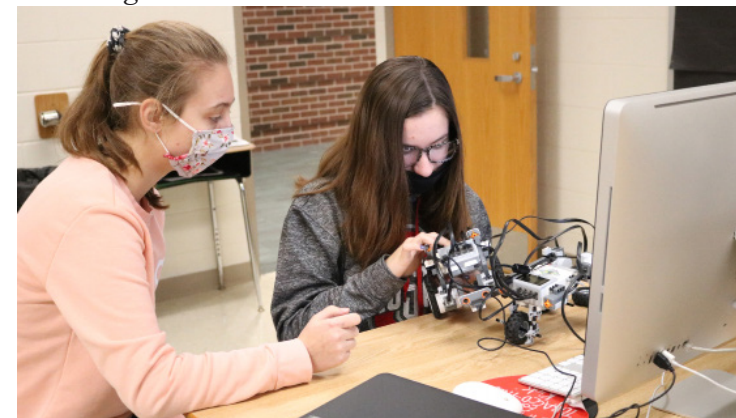

The College and Career Readiness class helped make gingerbread houses with Audrey VonSossan and Kaleb Metzger.



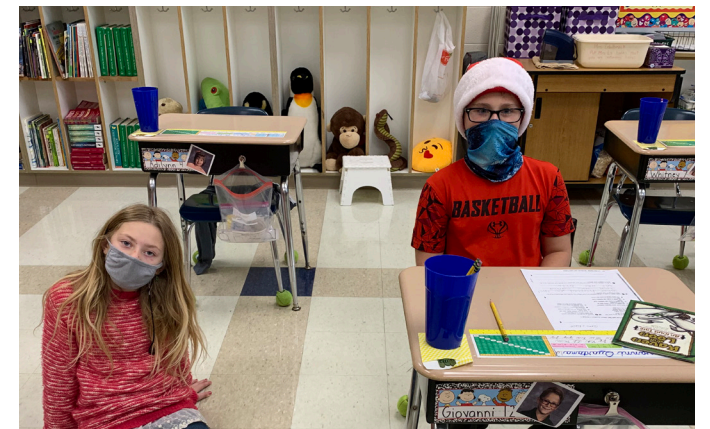
Third graders Greyson Beaubien and Adilynn Birkemeier find a way to social distance but still work together!

FREE LUNCH PROGRAM EXTENDED

Dear Parents,

Ottoville Local School District will continue to take advantage of the USDA free lunch program that has been extended through the end of the academic school year. Please note this benefit is for ALL Ottoville Local students 18 years and younger to receive FREE LUNCHESES through the end of the 2020-2021 academic school year OR until USDA funds are depleted whichever comes first.

This does not include Ala Carte items, Kindergarten snack, extra main entrée and extra milk, but they will still be available for your student to purchase at the normal cost.

You are not required to fill out the Free/Reduced application to receive this. However, if you qualify for reduced or free lunches, you MUST still fill out the application to continue to receive this benefit once the USDA funds are depleted. This application may also pertain to other benefits that are related to the reduced or free lunch qualification.

Previous lunch negative balances and book bills still need to be paid upon notification. It is our hope that the extension of the free lunch program will allow parents/guardians to pay book bills and class fees in a timely fashion.

Once the USDA funds are depleted, all lunchroom fees will resume.
