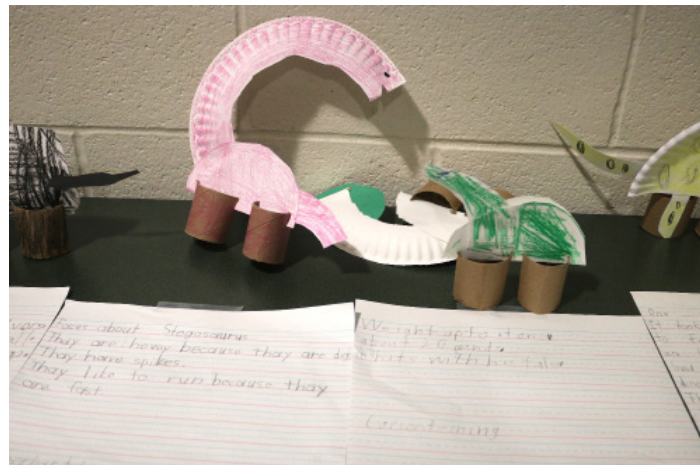
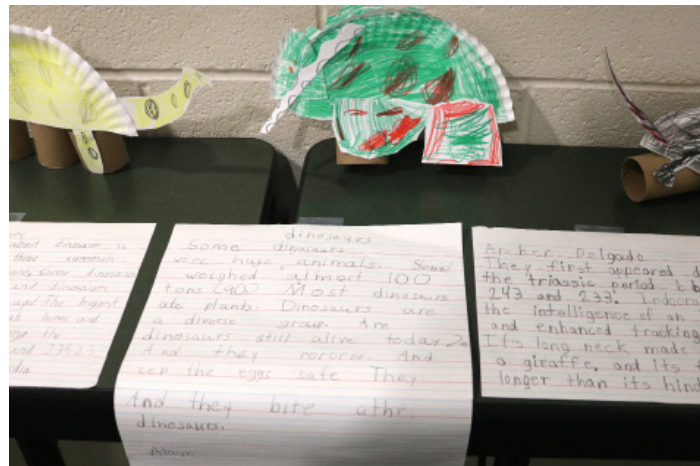


COUNTY SCIENCE FAIR RESULTS (15 OTTOVILLE PARTICIPANTS)
