This C.A.R.E Module fulfills the requirements set by law in the new PA legislation passed in December 2014. (Act 195-School Access to Emergency Epinephrine Act) School district employees in PA who may be administering emergency epinephrine to individuals must now complete a training session that is approved by the PA Department of Health. The C.A.R.E. Module is an approved training method. The module also focuses on preventative strategies for district personnel to minimize possible exposure to food allergens.

Instructions for completing the C.A.R.E. module:

- 1. Go to website: www.allergyready.com.
- 2. Create your log in ID and password using the instructions provided on the website. Keep this ID and password written down for future use. Use your South Fayette email address when asked to provide an email address while registering for this account. You will receive an email confirmation after completion of the course, with information on retrieving your certificate, if you are unable to print your certificate immediately.
- 3. Log in with your new ID and password and complete the C.A.R.E. module. This module takes approximately one hour in totality , but can be saved for completion at a later time.
- 4. Print out your certificate immediately. Make 2 copies. One to keep for yourself and one for Vicki Adams to keep in your personnel file.
- 5. You may use a personal email, if you do not have a South Fayette email.
- 6. After completion of the module, you will have an opportunity to practice with the 3 different types of auto injectors with one of the district nurses. This step is not optional.
