

Meetings



Safety / Security

- Life Safety Systems (fire sprinklers, alarms, security systems, etc)
- Entry Airlock/secured control of building front and bus drop off area.

Accessibility

• Make the building fully accessible – this includes all areas & levels including interior/exterior.

Auditorium

- Needs minimal aesthetic upgrades, priorities should be systems & A/V
- Would like to have stage fully handicapped accessible from within the house.





Foodservice / Dining

- Upgrade area for scratch cooking support on site. Most food is off-site prep/warming and will continue to do so
- Expand the dining area to provide more "breathing room".

Public Central Lobby Area

- Upgrades to support gymnasium / auditorium functions (larger restrooms, adult-only dedicated restrooms, etc)
- Reconfigured/relocated offices that currently are in former locker room areas.

General Updates/ Renovations

• The team assumed that overall general upgrades, infrastructure repairs, building maintenance, finishes upgrades, façade/building shell renovations, etc. will be made as a part of the project.



Future Consideration & Questions:

 Does this facility ever need to be replaced? The team had discussion about replacement versus renovation, and how the District may decide to remove the building in the future.

- Number of Entry / Exits Securing all doors is challenging with after school events

Playground Improvements

• Repair and resolve drainage issues in playground, currently unusable half the year due to these issues

New Addition / Auditorium

- Provide an auditorium in this building which allows a space for large gatherings for staff / parent meetings
- Opportunity for better acoustics, storage for instruments
- Additional space for art, theater and music programs

Safety / Security

- Main Entry no security vestibule, low visibility
- Number of Entry / Exits too many, difficult to supervise
- Drop-off & Pick-up doubles as outdoor recess space

Efficient Use of Land & Building

- Site layout outdoor recess, parking, access
- Community / 'Hub' spaces multi-purpose room, media center
- Green space better connection to outdoors
- Back part of building access storage needs

Comfort & Performance

- Update HVAC systems temperature issues throughout
- Improve Building envelope

Roof





General Communal Spaces

- Need collaboration / team spaces
- Make Community spaces more centralized and easy to access
- Multi-purpose room lacks natural light / views, inflexible, outdated furniture

Classroom Spaces

- New, updated furniture existing limited flexibility & seating options
- Challenges with science lab
- Lack of storage
- Provide Technology upgrades

Building Infrastructure

• The team assumed that overall general upgrades, infrastructure repairs, building maintenance, finishes upgrades, façade/building shell renovations, etc. will be made as a part of the project.











Future Consideration & Questions:

- Renovation vs. New Build Execution: How does the execution of the plan work? What does that look like and what is the impact on the students?
- Renovation vs. New Build Financial sense: What is the operating expense cost savings per year of new building as compared to a renovated building? What is the Return on Investment?
- Community Perception and Trust: Does the community involvement process factor into District decisions? Does the District have a priority for which facility should undergo a major project?



Holistic Approach

 Include Middle School when considering improvements to the High School, needs at the high school could directly benefit the Middle School (performing arts and athletics)

Natatorium

- Consider building a natatorium for students and community
- Legacy of competitive swimmers at high school, Indian Hill Hall of Fame includes many swimmers

Media Center

- Develop media center into flexible multi-purpose learning commons
- Consider current and future learning needs
- Provide different kinds of spaces to accommodate different types of learning (quiet spaces, group collaboration, maker space, etc.





Renewable Energy

• Investigate options to incorporate renewable energy into projects and facilities, including solar and geothermal

General Updates

- The team recognizes this is a new building, but the high school needs to continue to evolve and also maintain infrastructure and upgrades to building systems, etc.
- AC Ventilation, HVAC Updates and Fire Suppression system in HS Gym.



Future Consideration & Questions:

- Feasibility Study: Will the District perform a study to analyze ROI and understand energy performance criteria?
- Student Feedback: Is the District going to receive student feedback through this process to better understand their needs?
- Community Perception: Is there a long-term central plant strategic plan to connect all facilities to central plant? How can there be better communication of this plan to the community? What is the Home of the Braves project perception and potential impact on improvements to high school and voter fatigue?
