



## **Greg Mack** *Biography*



Mr. Greg Mack serves as Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Operations in Spartanburg School District Three and has held this post since August, 2007. Previously, he served six years as Assistant Superintendent for Operations in Newberry County School District.

Mr. Mack has demonstrated an impressive track record leading several financial and building projects. He has led the implementation of modernized accounting and reporting software, made strides in building operations and maintenance resulting in cleaner schools, completed two \$20 million construction programs to build a combined middle and high school complex, one elementary school, two major renovations, and two major additions, and implemented an \$84 million construction program utilizing the Installment Purchase Revenue Bonds funding mechanism.

In Newberry, Mr. Mack earned several important certifications and awards including six Certificates of Excellence in Financial Reporting from both the Governmental Finance Officers Association and the Association of School Business Officials International. The restoration of Newberry Elementary School earned a CEFPI Design Excellence Award and an article published in the American School Board Journal.
