# Transcript

Official high school transcript through 1<sup>st</sup> semester of senior year (request from your guidance counselor)

### **Two Letters of Recommendation**

One letter from a teacher (from any grade level here at Bath) and one letter from a personal recommendation (coach, pastor, mentor, community leader, guidance counselor, principal, boss, etc.) \*This cannot be a relative and should be a 'person of authority or high respect'.

### **Personal Statement**

A written personal statement that must address:

- Your future plans (college, university, trade school, major/degree, credentials required, etc.)
- Your involvement (sports, clubs, jobs, hobbies, volunteer work, etc.)
- Any notable achievements (awards, honors, titles, promotions, etc.)
- Your response to this prompt: "Explain your journey to becoming a true scholar (no matter how unconventional) and describe your plan to be a life-long learner (what does that mean to you and how will you live that out)?"

## **Signed Agreement**

You and a guardian must sign the agreement at the bottom of this scholarship form.

Your full application stapled to this page must be turned into the guidance office by **the last Monday in April**. Only complete applications with all criteria will be considered.
