# Did you know that having a job over winter break can earn a Graduation Seal?

#### WHAT IS THE OHIO MEANS JOBS SEAL?

The Ohio Mean Jobs Seal is like an abbreviated resume where students can highlight their employability skills; these skills can be developed at school, work, or through community organizations and service.

#### WHO CAN EARN THE OMJ SEAL?

Any student who is employed, has been employed and still maintains a positive relationship with the past supervisor, participates in community service, works with community organizations like Boys Scouts or church youth groups for example, or career technical students with job/shadowing placements. The expectation is that students are "working" outside of school to develop their employability skills.





