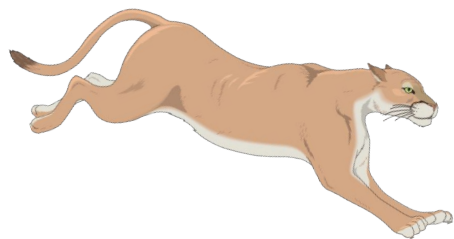



## Registration for the 26/27 School Year

via **FinalForms**

Parents/Guardians,

Annual student registration and consent forms will now be processed in our FinalForms system -- this replaces the old OneView system.

### **Parents and guardians with existing FinalForms accounts:**

If you have an existing FinalForms account (used for athletics or extracurricular activities), you may now sign into that account to complete your annual forms for the 26-27 school year at this link.

### **Parent and guardians without an existing FinalForms account:**

The email address that was previously used for updating the OneView forms has been loaded into the Final Forms system. You should have received an email from FinalForms ([mailmain@finalforms.com](mailto:mailmain@finalforms.com)) asking you to confirm your account. The link within the email will allow you to set up your account, create your password and so forth. If you do not have the email click [this link](#).

It is important to note that we are asking parents/guardians to update forms in the 26-27 school year. When you log into FinalForms, you need to switch to the new school year to update your forms.

It is also important to note that since this is a new system, no data from the old OneView system will be pre-populated. You will have to complete the forms in their entirety this first year.

## ATTENTION SENIORS

### Notice regarding your Google Account

We want to share important information regarding student Google accounts (Google Drive, Gmail, and other Google services provided by the district).

### Account Access Timeline

Student Google accounts will be **disabled shortly after graduation** and **permanently removed after a grace period of approximately 90 days**.

After this date, all files and data associated with the account—including documents, photos, videos, and emails—will be permanently deleted and cannot be recovered.

### What You Should Do Before Graduation

If you would like to keep any of your files, we strongly encourage you to take action before your account is removed.

Here are a few recommended options if you wish to retain your files:

### Download Your Files

- Log into your school Google account
- Use **Google Takeout** ([takeout.google.com](https://takeout.google.com)) to export all your data at once  
*or*
- Manually download important files from Google Drive to a personal device

### Important Notes

- Once accounts are deleted, **the district cannot recover any data**
- Files shared with others may become inaccessible if you were the owner

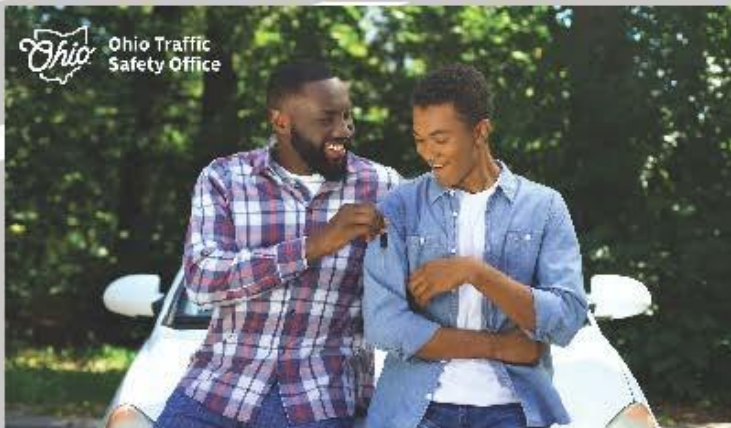
