Please join us in congratulating the Southview Cougars Freshman Football Team on completing a **perfect season** and **winning the Northern Lakes League Championship!** The Cougars outscored their opponents 293 to 14 for nearly a 40-point average margin of victory, while recording 5 shut-outs. They outgained opponents by 342 yards per game, punting only 3 times all season while opposing teams averaged only 4 first downs per contest. The highlight of the season was a 49 - 0 title clinching victory over our cross-town rivals in which Northview was limited to negative 29 yards of total offense.
