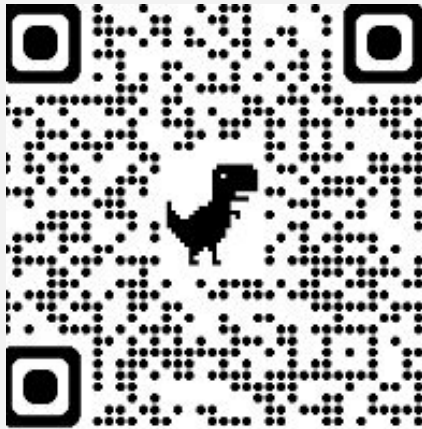

Policy Changes

We educators are in a very difficult position with **artificial intelligence**. On one hand, we recognize that this is the way of the future, and our students will become adults in a world that is dominated by this technology. On the other hand, this tool is capable of dramatically undermining the process of teaching students to think critically and communicate effectively.

Therefore, with some fear of sounding like a Luddite, we have instituted two important policy changes: 1) **Students must use their school Google account and applications for all work that is being submitted** and 2) The edit history of all submissions must be made viewable to teachers upon request. Submissions from other accounts or ones that show large content “dumps” will be considered plagiarism and will not receive credit.

To their credit, our teachers are learning to adapt with the technology, sometimes even incorporating it into their lessons or assignments. But, we are clearly losing the arms race at this moment.

This policy is meant to help students learn to reason, to be creative, and to communicate effectively. It is not meant to stifle their progress towards an inevitable future.

Begin with 90 days and then **subtract** days that you are absent, on field trips, making up a missed test, snow days, etc. If aiding during your **Science Lab**, start with **44 days per semester**.
