

- Great practice for the SAT and other standardized tests
- ★ PSAT/NMSQT scores determine eligibility and qualification for the National Merit Scholarship Program, which can earn scholarship money!



## WHO SHOULD TAKE THE PSAT/NMSQT?

- Sophomores & juniors considering whether the ACT or SAT is the best for them.
  - Juniors who are trying to earn National Merit Recognition and sophomores who plan to try in their junior year.

#### **Nominate a Faculty Member...**




#### What is Broomball?
