A program designed to assist historically underrepresented groups in reaching their fullest potential to ensure success in high school, college, or the career field. Educators are taught skills that have proven success in the classroom (WICOR). These lifelong strategies help students design their own futures: critical thinking, collaboration, reading, writing, and relationship building are crucial in developing a more confident sense of self.



AVID ACTIVITIES

- College field trips and education, along with scholarship assistance
- Career exploration (Major Clarity) and educational opportunities
- Study skills enhancement, focused notetaking, and binder checks
- Community-based learning environment

HISTORY OF AVID

The AVID program founded by Mary Catherine Swanson at Clairemont High School, with the first class taking the elective in 1980. According to AVID.org, AVID is now implemented in more than 6,400 schools in 47 states across the U.S., plus schools in DoDEA, Canada, and Australia. AVID impacts 2 million students in grades K-12 and 50 postsecondary institutions.


