You have taken the 16 personalities assessment. 16 personalities is a framework that evolved from the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI). MBTI is the earlier assessment used for understanding personality. It gives insight on how people make decisions, process information, and interact with others. The 16 personalities assessments adds one letter at the end of the personality type to give you more specific information about your personality.
