### **Bullying Incident Report**

Sylvania Schools has actively integrated the requirements of House Bill 276 regarding harassment, intimidation, and bullying (HIB) into the school environment. Each school has put into practice these policies and procedures along with an educational component to teach and help all students learn about this complex issue. Sylvania Schools will continue to address all aspects of harassment, intimidation and bullying in a forthright manner for the benefit of all students. Definition of Bullying: Harassment, intimidation, or bullying (HIB) means any intentional written, verbal, graphic, or physical act that a student or group of students exhibit toward another particular student more than once, which behavior both causes mental or physical harm to the other student, and is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student.

The following is a summary of reported incidents for the district:

#### **August 2019 - December 2019**

The total number of incidents of harassment, intimidation, and bullying as reported by the elementary schools is eight (8) incidents, the junior high schools six (6) and the high schools reported ten (10).

#### **January 2020 – May 2020**

The total number of incidents of harassment, intimidation, and bullying as reported by the elementary schools is ten (10) incidents, the junior high schools eleven (11) and the high schools reported fourteen (14).
