Sylvania students participate in a variety of Visual and Performing Arts courses and activities. Throughout the year, students participate in art shows, musical performances and compete in competitions.



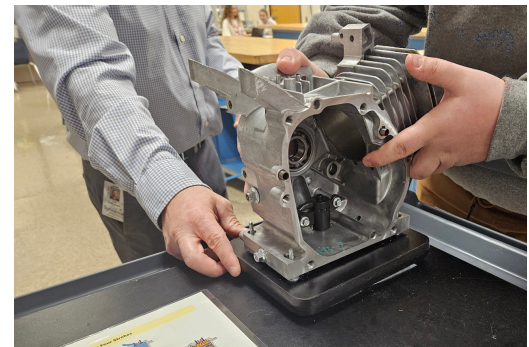
ATHLETICS & EXTRACURRICULARS

CommUnity

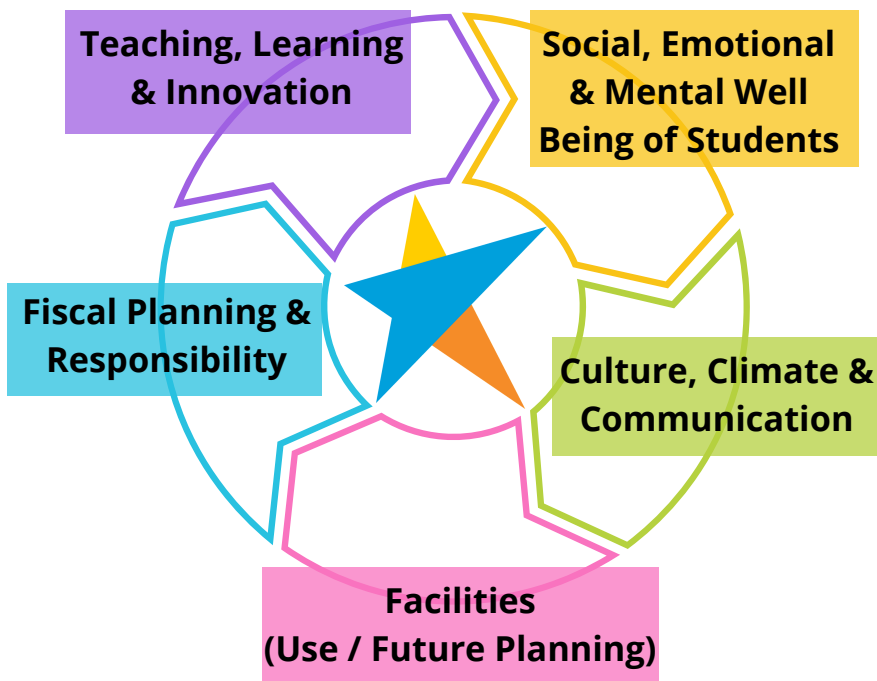
