SUPPLY LIST 2026-2027

Kindergarten

- Backpack for carrying binders home each day
- 4 packages of glue sticks (4 per pack)
- 4 boxes of crayons – no more than 24 per box please (1 box for each quarter)
- 1 package of **small** black dry erase markers
- 2 boxes of Ticonderoga **sharpened** #2 pencils
- Scissors (Fiskars brand is great)
- 2 pink erasers (no pencil cap erasers)
- 1” 3-ring binder, **durable** with clear presentation “view sleeve” on front and with pockets inside
- 1 **plastic** pocket folder with 3 holes (no prongs)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 2 containers of antibacterial wipes
- 1 pair inexpensive headphones (no earbuds) – *please put in a plastic bag labeled with your child’s name*
- 1 old smock or shirt to protect clothes during messy projects – *please label with name*
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- Change of clothes to keep in locker for potential accidents/spills (extra pants, underwear, socks)

Grade 1

- Plastic supply box for inside the desk

Grade 2

- 2 Boxes of markers
- 1 Box of colored pencils
- 8 Glue sticks
- 2 Highlighters
- 10 **Black** dry erase markers (preferably EXPO brand)
- 1 eraser or tube sock for dry erase boards
- Paint smock or adult size t-shirt for art – *labeled with name*
- 1 Box of **pre-sharpened Ticonderoga** pencils
- 1 Clipboard – *labeled with name*
- 1 Pair of **wired** headphones (no bluetooth)
- 2 Large boxes of tissues OR 4 small boxes of tissues
- 2 Canisters of Clorox wipes
- 2 Rolls of paper towels
